FROM THE PRESIDENT:

Helping to sing PIRATES on 23 March, I'll be recalling two former productions, one in 1981 and one in 1998. Both were produced by the late Rob Newson, the one in 1998 being his last with us (and my first as Musical Director). It was "Robin's Return" to us after a long gap, and he brought along a large male contingent to swell the ranks of pirates and police, from his main activity in those days – the Sheringham Shantymen.

Most of these chaps stayed with us (as Heavy Dragoons or whatever) for several years at least. Among them was Frank Wisbey (a convincing and rumbustious pirate), to whom we've lately had to say a sad goodbye. He was in most shows from that time until 2004, returning finally for Tantantara Tzing Boom in autumn 2009. A loyal chorus member, he occasionally got a special mention – 'Albert the Butler' in Candlelit Capers II, and one of the Guards in 'Princess Ida'. Many of us will miss Frank, remembering his happy grin which enhanced the male chorus line, besides his being musically useful.

How many of you keep old programmes? Personally, I find browsing through mine rewarding and sometimes surprising!
