Two main aspects of my own pleasure; first, at presenting local audiences - and aren't we lucky in our Theatre - with these wonderful words-and-music offerings, and (a very close second) the making of lasting friendships with so many talented and sympathetic and (dare I say) Absolutely Fabulous people. We leave you with feelings of pleasure. Take heart of grace!
